### How Grade 8 learners can register their Ask Archie Maths software:

#### Step 1:

-Registration can be done by clicking the "**High School Registration**" TAB - found on the right hand side of the Ask Archie [www.askarchie.co.za](http://www.askarchie.co.za) home page.

#### Step 2:

-Insert our unique school code, which is **GREY234** and fill out the Grade 8 software registration form.

#### Step 3:

-A Username and Password for the Grade 8 software will then be SMS'd and Emailed to you, so that you can start using your software.

Learners can then access Ask Archie via their unique *username* and *password* login at home or at school.

**PLEASE ENCOURAGE LEARNERS TO REGISTER ON A PC OR LAPTOP - AS OPPOSED TO A TABLET. (OUR MATHS APP IS STILL BEING DEVELOPED FOR TABLETS)**
