GOLF PROGRAM

Golf has been played at Grey for many years, but was regarded as a special sport until 2000. Prior to 2000 boys had to get special permission to play the sport. Since 2000 Grey High Golf has gone from strength to strength and became one of the best golf playing schools in South Africa in the past 25 years.

Since 2004, no other school in South Africa managed to qualify more often Grey High School for the National School's Finals. This is a testament to the dominance Grey golf has had not just in our province, but also nationally.

FORMAT OF FIXTURES:

Schools league:

Stableford Competition. All individual Stableford points of each player in the team are combined to calculate the teams overall score.

Derby Fixtures: The Match Play format is used.

DRESS:

Matches: White Grey Golf shirt and Khaki Golf pants. OR Sky Blue golf shirt and black pants

Practises: Any suitable Golf shirt and Golf pants.

Weekly routine: Monday: League matches

Tuesday & Thursday: Practice



FRAMEWORK OF TEAMS & CATEGORIES

Proudly 45 boys play the sport each year.
Schools League: A-league 1st, 2nd and 3rd teams
B-league 4th, 5th and 6th teams
Derby Fixtures: 1st team (2nd Team will play when other schools have enough players to field a 2nd team.)



UK GOLF TOURS

Grey Golfers have been fortunate over the years to tour the UK. They were provided the opportunity to play many of the Open Championship courses and a number of players were lucky enough to play the “Old Course” at St. Andrews which is the pinnacle for any golfer.

We have taken tours in 2008, 2015, 2018 and 2023. The next tour is planned for 2026 and it promises to be another wonderful experience for our players that will be afforded the opportunity to play 7 Open Championship courses that will include the “Old Course” at St. Andrews.
