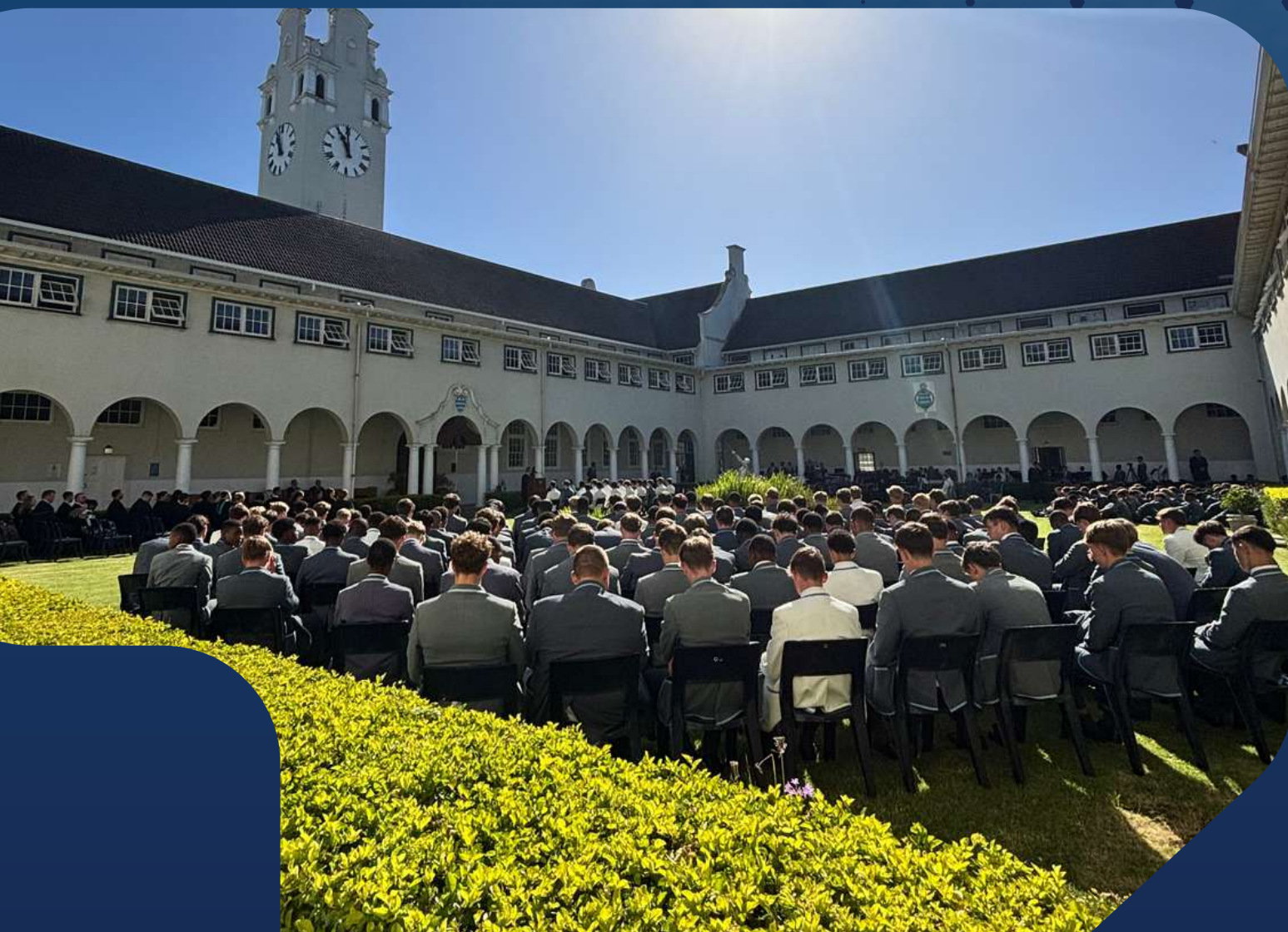

SIGHT & SOUND PROGRAM

The Sight & Sound program facilitates media production at Grey High School. This program enables students to get practical experience of all aspects of live broadcasting. Students are equipped with the skills to run the entire broadcast, from setting up cameras to managing switchboards and directing live streams. In order to facilitate quality production, students train under professional broadcasters in grades 8-10 until they are able to manage and run their own product of live sport events in grades 11-12.

GREY HIGH SIGHT & SOUND GOALS

- We are looking to expand our inventory and gear to enable coverage of all events and fields during festivals and derbies so that all teams, regardless of prestige or level, get a fair opportunity for coverage.
- We are also looking at branching the Sight & Sound team to train boys in editing and post-production to give them first-hand experience in producing quality edits and footage for social media, such as highlight videos, documentary-style edits and other forms of media that extends beyond sport coverage.



FRAMEWORK OF TEAMS & CATEGORIES

Sight & Sound filming comprises of two frameworks, namely filming and production. Filming covers the camerawork and videography that is required for streaming. This is often handled by grades 8-10, who are guided over communications by the producers. Once boys are comfortable with the videography, they are encouraged to work behind the scenes in production where they manage the live stream, camera guidance, and switchboards.



COVERAGE OF FESTIVALS

The rugby festival is often our most demanding and prestigious event for coverage due to the high stakes and spectatorship, during viewers in from around the country. Boys are also eager to be part of the production for hockey and rugby first team games. The u15 Waterpolo tournament is also a big event that boys look forward to.
